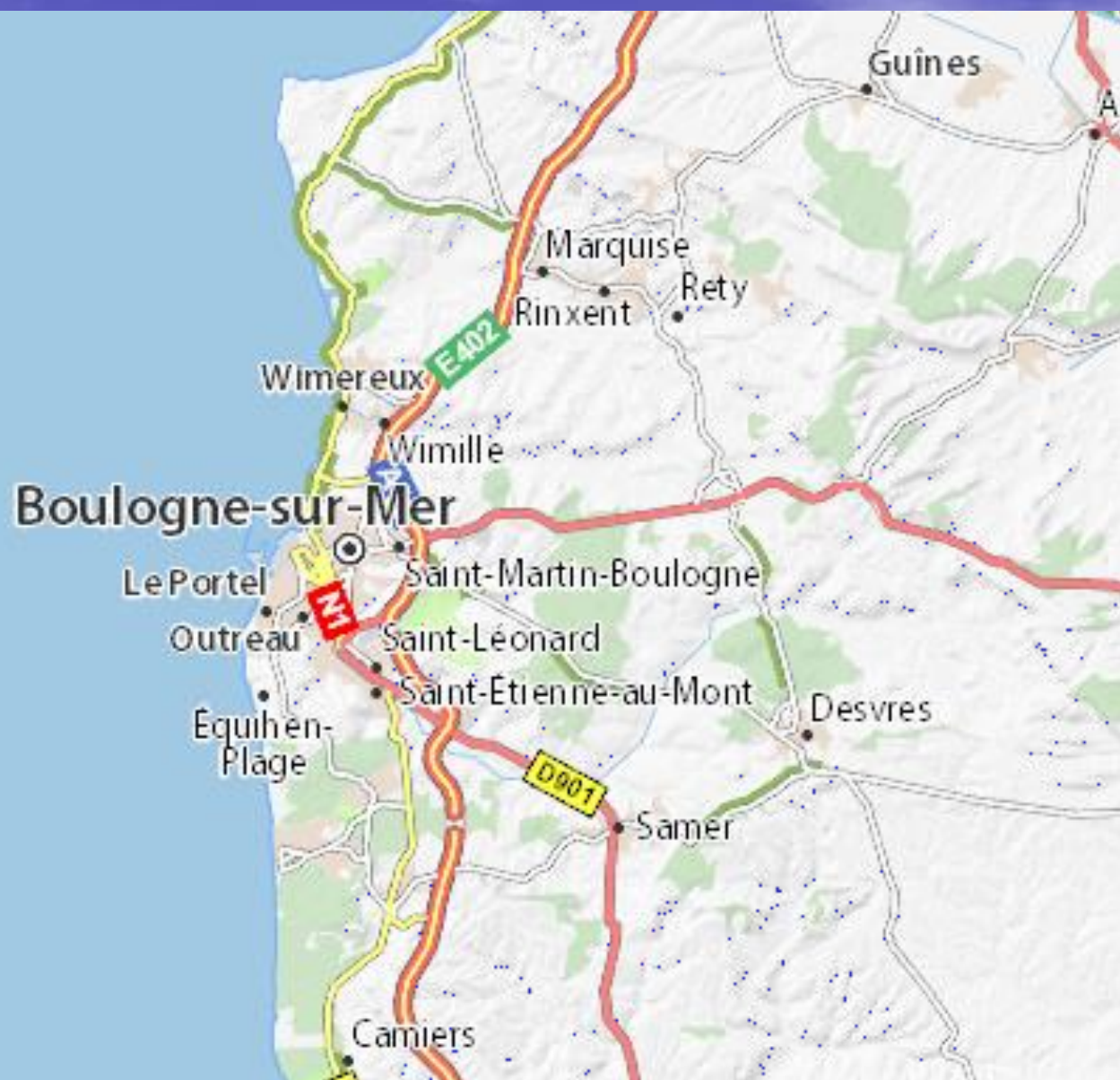

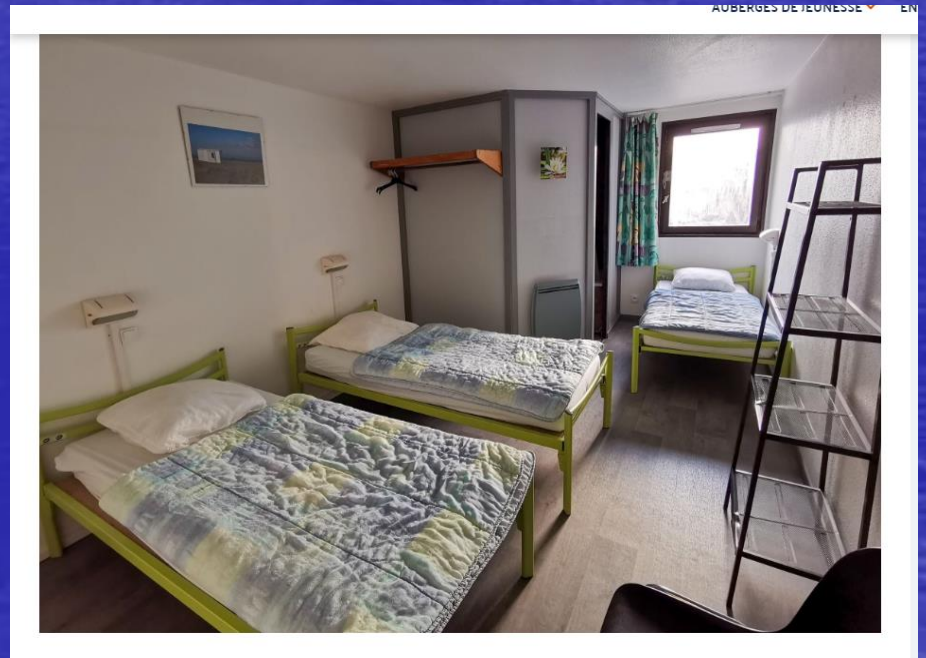

Children need to arrive at school, wearing school uniform, on Monday 20th June at **8:20 am**. Please ensure that their clothes are packed in suitable cases so that the children can carry them. Return

Medicines

Spending Money

A suggested minimum is 20 € with an absolute maximum of 40 €. Children will not be allowed to spend in excess of this. Please provide notes of NO larger than 5 €

No English currency should be taken.

Spending money should be in 2 named purses/wallets. One in their day bag with 5 €

The second purse should be packed in their case.

Packed Lunch

2 fully disposable lunches please, plus a refillable water bottle (2 bottles if possible)

Please do not put food in suitcases....we will need to remove it on site.

Drinking Water

The children are not to drink water from the taps at the centre we will provide them with bottled water.

Cameras

Swimming

On the Thursday morning we will be spending the morning at a swimming pool. It is supervised by lifeguards. Please note that no bikinis or swimming shorts are to be worn.

Expectations

The children will be told of the behaviour expectations for each part of the trip.

Suggested clothing list for Boulogne Sur Mer, France

Please ensure that a combination of loose light clothing as well as warm and waterproof clothing is packed.

It is essential that EVERYTHING is named.

2 sets of nightclothes 6 pairs of pants 6 pairs of socks

3 pairs of trousers/jeans Shorts

Evening clothes (boys are encouraged to wear a tie for dinner)

4 shirts/blouses (with sleeves for protection from the sun) 2 jumpers

Waterproof anoraks with hood or separate hat

Old towel for the beach Sun hat

Swimming costume and towel (bikinis and long trunks are not allowed in the water park)

Handkerchiefs or a box of tissues

Footwear: 1 pair of stout shoes 1 pair of trainers/plimsolls

Toilet Gear: Soap, flannel, toothbrush, toothpaste, comb, hairbrush, shampoo, suntan lotion, handtowel

Large, named plastic bag for dirty clothes

Small rucksack (with packed lunch and drinks)

2 small purses - clearly marked with name and school

Small pencil case with a few colouring pencils

Watches and cameras, may be taken, but responsibility for these remain with the child.

NO mobile phones, radios, electronic games or battery chargers hair dryers or computers

PLEASE NO SNACKS in cases...if so these will be “looked after” until your child’s return
