



What to do when you get here:

When you get to the Crawley Foyer building, if you are looking at the building, you will see two doors: the door to the right is for Crawley Foyer and the door to the left is Crawley YAC.



The YAC door is the one nearest to Hallan Cash and Carry. The door has a blue Dialogue Counselling Sign to the left-hand side of the buzzer. To gain entry, please press the buzzer and a member of the YAC team will let you in.

COVID Guidance:

Before entering the YAC, a worker will ask you the following COVID screening questions before you can enter the drop-in space:

- Have you tested positive for COVID or had any COVID symptoms within the past 10 days?
- Have you been in close contact with anyone who has tested positive for COVID or had any COVID symptoms within the past 10 days?
- . Are you happy to wear a face covering for the duration of your session at YAC?

How to get to YAC:

The YAC (Youth Advice Centre) is located at Crawley Foyer on Horsham Road, RH11 7AQ. The nearest major landmark is the ASDA on Pegler Way; the entrance to the YAC is opposite Hallan Cash & Carry. We are a ten-minute walk from the train station or Town Centre for those travelling into Crawley from out of town, or accessible by bus or foot for those travelling from within Crawley. Alternatively, YAC can be accessed on road via the A23.

By Bus: The number 23 METRO bus stops directly outside the YAC, or the Number 1 & 2 buses stop in the town centre, which is a short walk away.

By Train: Get off the train at Crawley Rail Station – then walk ten minutes to the YAC.

By Car: There is no parking for service users at the YAC; please park at Goffs Park Car Park on Horsham Road and walk over the level crossing towards the YAC.
