Can we please remind all parents and carers that for safety reasons cycling on the school playground and premises is strictly forbidden (for both children and adults). Please just push them. The children's safety is our priority and we would like to thank you in advance for adhering to the no cycling rule.

Whilst we allow any child to cycle to school we expect that until they have met the standards of the Bikeability scheme (in Year 6) they are accompanied by an adult.

## **Arbor communication system**



As you may be aware we are using communication system Arbor and all communications to you as parents are sent via this portal. With this system you are not only able to make payments, but also update your contact details, change of address, and most importantly access your child's profile and update it with any medical information. We would like to encourage all parents to visit this to ensure all information we hold are up-to-date.

The accounts have been set up for you and all you need to do is finishing creating your account. Your username will be the email address you have provided to us previously. If your email address has changed, please do update the School Office via email.

To finish creating your account, you just need to set a password. You will then need to click on 'First time logging in?' and follow the instructions on screen.
